Dato Prof Dr Ahmad Farhan Mohd Sadullah

Dato' Prof. Dr. Ahmad Farhan Mohd. Sadullah, 57, has been appointed as the Vice-Chancellor, Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) for three years from 2 October 2023 to 17 September 2026.

He obtained a Doctor of Philosophy in Transport Studies from the University of London in 1995, a Master of Science in Transport from the same university in 1990 and an Imperial College Diploma (DIC) from the Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine in 1990.

Previously, he held the position of Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic and International), USM from 2017 to 2020. sal

Dato' Prof. Dr. Ahmad Farhan began his career as a USM lecturer in 1995 and held the positions of Coordinator of the Innovation and Technology Development Unit (2000 – 2004), Dean of the Engineering and Technology Research Platform (2004 – 2006) and Director of Innovation, USM Research and Innovation Division (2006 – 2007).

Born in Petaling Jaya, Selangor, he was the recipient of the Road Safety Figure Award in 2015 for his contribution to the field of transportation engineering at the national and international levels.

In addition, he was appointed as the Head of the National Blue Ocean Strategy (NBOS) Cluster for Road Safety and a Member of the Land Public Transport Commission (SPAD) and served as the Director General of the Malaysian Institute of Road Safety Research (MIROS) from 2008 to 2011.

Dato' Prof Dr. Ahmad Farhan is also involved in various committees at the national and international levels involving the field of transportation covering road safety, public transport, transport sustainability, Intelligent Transport Systems as well as travel behaviour and traffic engineering
